Dear Parents and Guardians of Incoming Cheney Tech Students class of 2021,

This letter is to remind you that the mandatory Class of 2021 Freshmen Orientation will be held on Wednesday, May 24, 2017, from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. Failure to attend may impact your son/daughter's "final acceptance" to the class of 2021.

As the end of the school year approaches, we would also like to remind parents and students that acceptance to Cheney Tech is contingent upon successful completion of the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade, with no serious disciplinary offenses. We will be requesting from your current Middle School Counseling Offices your final 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Report Card, Disciplinary Record, and the Student's Health Records be forwarded to Cheney Technical High School during the months of June and July.

Transportation to Cheney Tech, including bus stops, pick-up and drop-off times, will be determined by your resident town Transportation Coordinator. For this reason, it is important that you keep Cheney Tech informed of any changes in your address, as we will be providing this information to your town's Board of Education during the month of July. If, by chance, you **no longer** wish to keep your child enrolled in Cheney Tech for the upcoming school year 2017-2018, please notify the School Counseling Department at (860) 649-5396 x316.

Cheney Tech has an Academic Dress Policy in place. All students will be required to purchase Cheney Tech Logoed Shirts and other attire from our uniform vendor. Freshmen will also be required to purchase "Exploratory" Shop Shirts which will be worn during the **trade cycles**. Our vendor will be here from 5:00pm to 8:00pm for orientation with samples for viewing and to take orders. Cheney Tech **will not** be selling any of these items, parents should order items in the months of June and July so that they may have their orders prior to the start of school. All 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are required to complete an initial assessment in Math. This assessments will be completed digitally. While attending Freshmen Orientation, all incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will have the opportunity to complete this mandatory assessment that evening. Doors will open at 3:00pm if you would like to bring your student early. It will take approximately 60 minutes for students to complete this assessment. No student will be able to start testing after 5:30pm.
